Project Period:

Established in November 2011 at Phulpahari, Paschim Medinipur, is an ongoing project.

Area/Districts of Operation:

Konkaboti Panchayat of Jangalmahal districts of Paschim Medinipur, Jhargram, Bankura and Purulia.

Number of Panchayats Covered: 4 above districts.

Number of Villages: Serves people in and around the above districts.

Beneficiaries: Number of direct as on March 2023,

- Under Swasthya Sathi Scheme – 6,978 Patients
- Under West Bengal Health Scheme – 110 Patients
- Under Employees State Scheme – 344 Patients
- Under Mediciam Scheme – 21 Patients

These 7,453 patients were treated in the hospital after proper diagnosis and Medical Blood Test, X-ray in the Bio-medical lab by General Physicians, Chest specialists, Gastroenterologists, Gynecologists, Orthopedic Surgeons and General Surgeons.

Covid-19 Critical Care Centre:

A separate ward was set aside for Covid patients.

- Total number of Covid-19 patients were treated in our hospital 52.
- Number of patients got completely cured 41.
- Number of patients passed away 11, these 11 patients could not be saved as they were brought to the hospital very late.





Tuberculosis Centre:

Tied up with the health department, Government of West Bengal, for the treatment of TB patients in four Districts of West Bengal namely, Paschim Medinipur, Jhargram, Bankura and Bishnupur.

Project Goals:

To continue to be a beacon of hope and healing for the citizens of this region.



Project Objectives:

To address the healthcare needs in the rural outskirts of Jangalmahal.



Project activities:

1. Out-Reach Leprosy Programme:

In order to reach out to the patients suffering from leprosy, the hospital is counting its fortnightly medical camps every month with one doctor and two staff nurses to do the regular medical checkups and also distribute medicines, ointments and dressing of the wounds. On an average there are more than 25 patients benefitting from these health camps.



2. Out-Reach Programme Medical Camps:

The out-reach programme which started in the month of November 2021 in collaboration with Seva Kendra Calcutta to reach out to the truck drivers, their families and the poor and deserving families of our neighbourhood in Kharagpur already saw successful completion of three medical camps conducted in the month of November and December, 2021. A team of Doctors, Nurses, Lab Technicians, Physiotherapists, Nutritionists and Eye Specialist were involved from our hospital where blood tests were done, eye checkups were conducted, medicines, eye drops and ointments were distributed. More such medical camps are lined up for the coming months.



Achievements:

- First non-government hospital to provide indoor treatment since April 2018 under Swasthya Sathi Scheme of Govt of West Bengal.
- A 10-bed hospital at the onset (2011) presently has 100+ beds with well-equipped departments.
- Partnerships with National Health Missions & Govt schemes.
