Project Area: Seva Kendra Calcutta, Head Office Kolkata.

Project Goal: The goal was to encourage greenery in Kolkata and serve as a training facility for saplings, flowering plants, equipment, and seedlings. The creation of little gardens on their vacant land and space acted as a role model for many of the locals. Therefore, the objective of raising knowledge of health and welfare, promoting self-sufficiency, and encouraging the establishment of small gardens was feasible.

Project Objectives:

- 1. To partially secure the food supply.
- 2. Encourage people to produce organic veggies in any feasible place.
- 3. Grow vegetables without the use of any chemicals, mostly utilizing coco-peat.

Project Activities:

- a) Soil Preparation: The basic ingredient, coco-peat, was well blended with soil, perlite, vermiculite, and cow dung.
- b) **Seeds Selection:** In order to have the best yield, it is important to choose the proper kind of seeds.
- c) **Tray Preparation:** The prepared trays are filled with the mixed soil and used to start seeds.
- d) The seeds are transferred to develop for additional growth after they have sprouted and produced two leaves. The roots are developed and fortified in the grow-bags. The roots are ultimately responsible for the plant's health.
