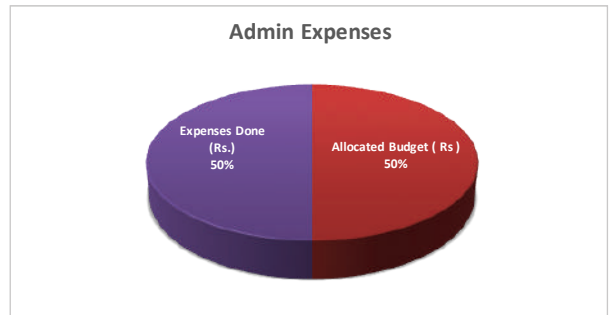

Project Goal:

To empower youth and make them eligible for employment.

Project Objectives:

- Providing the best patient care and promoting training that ensures overall patient support.
- Helps maintain a conducive environment in various departments of the hospital/home setting.

Project Activities:

Every month, we hold a Career Counselling Program, and every three months we hold an Employment Engagement Program and every week we provide a motivation session to our students by our old placed candidates.

Achievements:

The total number of students trained throughout the project duration is 112 youths and 73 (62%) of them are placed.

Impact:

The GDA Program is an important driver to develop gainful employment opportunities for rural youth. It will address poverty reduction by improving employability, and productivity and helps to sustainable enterprise development and inclusive growth.

Story of Change:

Stories of change: Gouri Bauri, age 19 years, a student of Term 2 Smile EIL Healthcare Training Programme, is currently working as Nurse Assistant under World Care Nursing Home since February 2023. She is undergoing as a trainee, a period of 3 months with a stipend of Rs 6000 per month. Post completion of trainee period she will be hired as permanent staff and her monthly remuneration will be revised based on her skills to Rs. 9000/- including free accommodation and fooding.

Gouri was hired as a trainee at World Care Nursing Home in Topsia as a General Duty Assistant in February 2023. She is undergoing hands-on experience of 3 months. She currently receives a salary of Rs. 6000/- per month. She is currently handling patients and providing primary patient care, how to feel enlarged livers by touching the surface of the upper abdomen as well as giving insulin among other tasks. "This is my first time working in a nursing home and I am learning a lot of skills on how to handle patients during emergencies. This field has interested me, and I aspire to become a highly qualified medical professional one day. I can now help my family members during any emergency at least", as stated by Gouri.
