**Objective:** To enhance community care and promote the development and learning of farmers at the Nazareth Farmers' Training Centre, also known as "Krishi Pathshala".



## Ongoing Projects and Activities:

## 1. Traditional Farming

## Initiation of Organic Farming:

The project team committed to promoting organic farming practices. Embarked on a significant journey to cultivate traditional paddy varieties in a 2-bigha plot.



#### Diverse Paddy Cultivation:

Cultivated four varieties of traditional paddy: Black, Kandagiri, Muggai, and Mayur Panki. Achieved a bountiful harvest of 1200 kgs without the use of synthetic fertilizers, and pesticides.

## Diversification and Innovation:

Impact extended beyond the harvest, leading to the centre evolving into a model of innovation. Features included a thriving Vegetable Nursery, flourishing Orchard, and Weed Composting Pit.

#### Knowledge Exchange Hub:

Became a learning space where farmers and project staff exchanged ideas and explored cutting-edge techniques.

## Future Expansion Plans:

Nazareth Farmers Training & Research Centre is gearing up for an even more promising year. Plans underway to expand cultivation to a 4-bigha expanse, embracing a wider array of traditional crops.
