COMMUNITY SENSITIZATION ON CHILD MARRIAGE

As part of the SKC project, a community sensitization programme on prevention of child marriage was conducted to raise awareness among community members about the harmful impacts of early marriage on children's health, education, and overall well-being. The session emphasized child rights, legal provisions related to child marriage, and the long-term social and emotional consequences of early marriage, especially for girls.



PROMOTING SUSTAINABLE FARMING FOR COMMUNITY RESILIENCE

Under the SKC project in West Midnapore, initiatives were undertaken to strengthen livelihoods and improve food security through the promotion of sustainable agrarian practices. The programme focused on encouraging eco-friendly farming methods that enhance soil health, conserve natural resources, and reduce input costs for small and marginal farmers.



SKILL BUILDING THROUGH VOCATIONAL TRAINING

The vocational training programme continued with students learning blouse stitching under the guidance of trainer Mrs. Nilima Mondal. The session focused on enhancing practical sewing skills and building confidence among the trainees. During the day, Mr. Anupam Sir from Seva Kendra Kolkata visited Katiahat and interacted with the vocational training students, encouraging them to stay committed to skill development and self-reliance.



Household Survey for Habitation Profiling at Bibi Bagan

A household survey was conducted at Bibi Bagan as part of habitation profiling to collect essential information on community conditions and needs. The survey aimed to support effective planning and strengthen community-based interventions through accurate field-level data.



SPREADING AWARENESS ON PREVENTION AND EARLY DETECTION

As part of the SKC project, a community sensitization programme on Tuberculosis (TB) awareness was conducted to educate community members about the causes, symptoms, prevention, and treatment of TB. The session emphasized the importance of early detection, timely medical consultation, and adherence to prescribed treatment to prevent the spread of the disease.



ENGLISH STUDY CLASS SESSION

An English study class was conducted at Bibi Bagan with the participation of 7 students. The session focused on improving basic language skills through interactive learning activities, encouraging student engagement and confidence.
