
Project Goal: Mainstreaming all the inmates into the society as law abiding and potential productive members.

reintegrate into society with dignity and self-sufficiency.




Outcome:

After completing the bakery training, the inmates at Sukanya Juvenile Home for girls will develop various valuable skills, including:

- **1. Baking Skills:** They will learn the art of baking, preparing a wide range of baked goods like bread, cakes, cookies, and pastries.
- **2. Food Safety and Hygiene:** They will be educated on the importance of maintaining high standards of food safety and hygiene in a bakery setting.
- **3. Time Management:** Learning to follow recipes and meet production deadlines will enhance their time management skills.
- **4. Teamwork:** Collaborating in a bakery environment will foster teamwork and communication abilities.
- **5. Entrepreneurship:** Some may acquire entrepreneurial skills, considering possibilities of starting their own bakery businesses in the future.
- **6. Self-Confidence:** As they master baking techniques, their self-confidence and self-esteem will improve significantly.
- **7. Problem-Solving:** They will learn to troubleshoot issues that may arise during the baking process, enhancing problem-solving skills.

Overall, these skills will equip the girls with the tools they need to lead productive and fulfilling lives beyond their time at the juvenile home.

Summary of classes and related information:



Highlights: Bakery classes at Sukanya Juvenile Home for Girls has identified 4 outstanding students in baking specialties of including dry fruitcake, vanilla cake, cinnamon cake, and banana walnut cake, additionally this training has benefitted 4 dropout inmates. A total of 144 hours were covered in 12 classes until March 2023. The students showed remarkable progress in their bakery skills, fostering hope for their future careers.
