



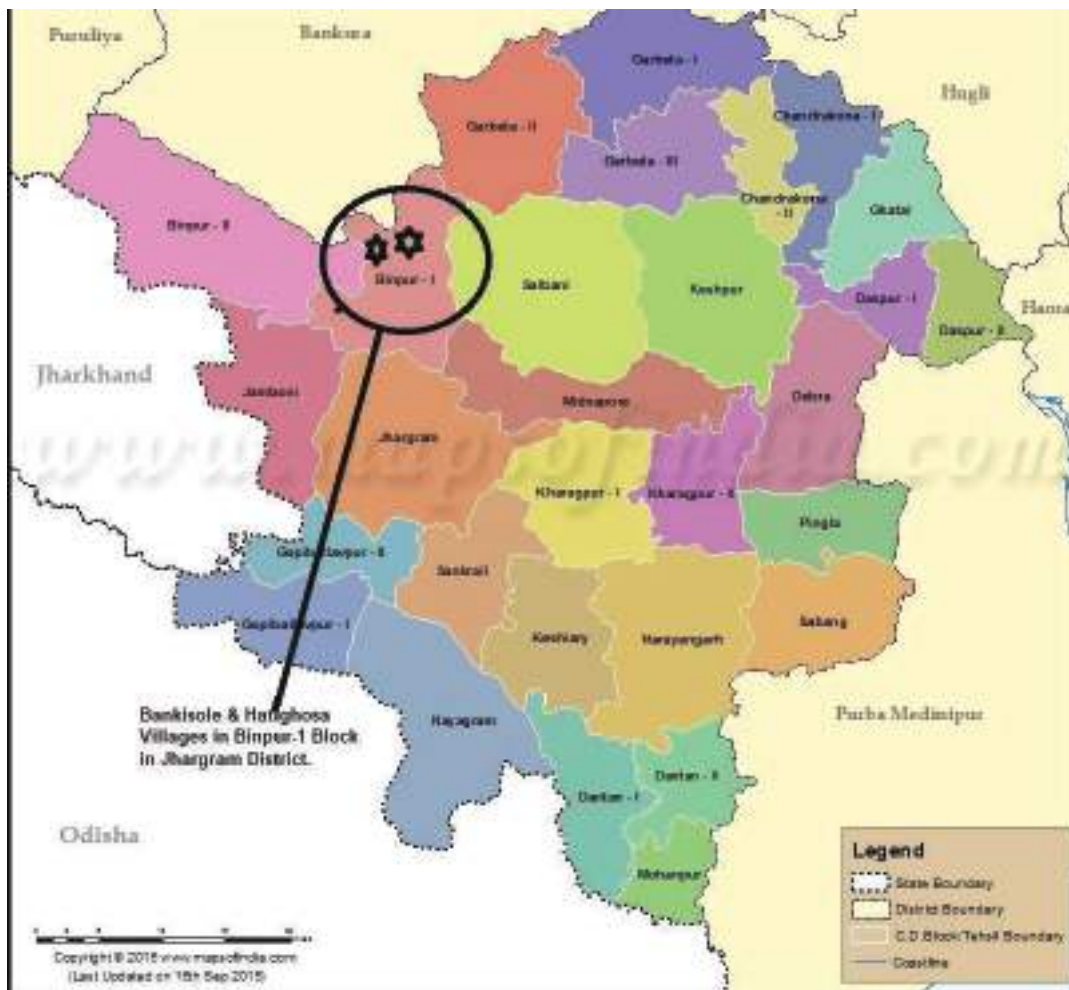


Educational Project for the Tribal Children at Bankisole

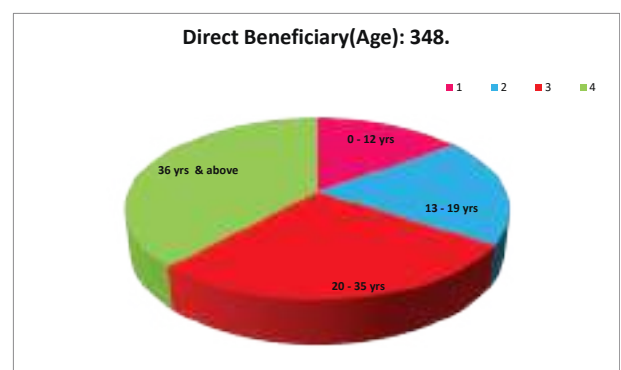
-  **Name of the Project:** Educational Project for the Tribal Children at Bankisole.

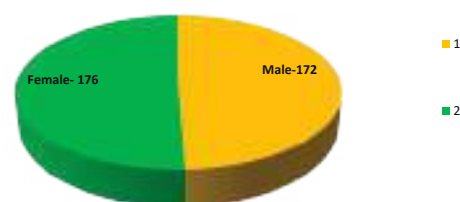

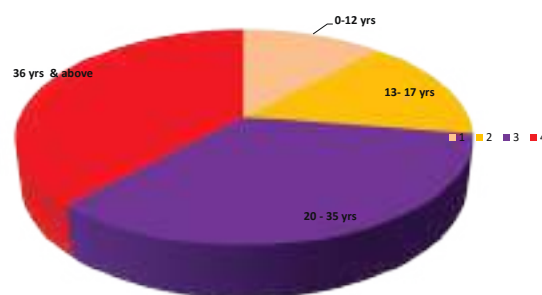
Direct Beneficiary(Gender): 348.



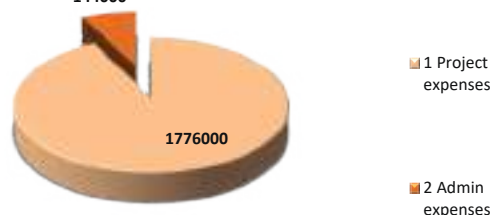
Indirect Beneficiaries(Gender): 1,406

🎯 Project Goal:

Improve the academic performance of the deprived students by delivering quality educational coaching support for their all-round growth and development and awareness building to the parents and caregivers.

📋 Project Objectives:

- To enroll the need based rural children especially the slow learners, irregular and deprived students, who have performed poorly due to financial constraint and neglect from family.
- To create a friendly learning approach by enhancing an innovative educational techniques leading to learning outcomes and simultaneously promoting co-curricular activities and inculcating good values among the students, in the coaching centers.
- To build Knowledge based awareness in the community, especially among women on social, environmental and health issues by sharing inputs, information and participatory learning to prevent violence, promote safety, and reduce social, health and ecological degradation.

👥 Project Activities:

- Educational coaching support for 40 deprived tribal students at Bankisole coaching center, six days a week, for 3 hrs following joyful learning methodology.



- Parents Meeting at Bankisole and Hatighosa villages involving their parents on Child Development Activities.



- Extracurricular activities at Bankisole and Hatighosa to enhance 'Child's Participation' in the coaching center like drawing, exercise, art and craft classes and other voluntary activities by the students.



- Celebration of 'Environment Day' 2022 with the theme 'Only One Earth' with 56 community members, followed by plantation programme and cotton bag distribution.



- Republic Day Celebration at Bankisole coaching center with 40 students and 19 parents on 26th January 2023.



- Hands-on Training on organic farming and sustainable nutrition garden preparation at Bankisole for 26 participants, along with seed distribution for 42 target families.



- International Women’s Day Celebration at Bankisole on 05.03.23 with 40 community members.



- Hands-on Training on assembling chain LEDs at Bankisole for 12 women and 4 men.



- Rapport building and advocacy in GP and block offices, health centers, Schools and ICDS centers.



- Donors visit at Bankisole by Ms. Danialle (From Joy for Kids) on 21.10.22 and was very pleased and impressed after interacting with the children and the mother's group.



Achievements:

- Total 34 families has cultivated nutrition gardens in their houses, with the help of the vegetable seeds distributed by SKC, following the Ecological farming mode.
- Total 5 slow learners were able to cope up with their daily lessons, during the coaching hours.
- Women's Day celebrated with great enthusiasm and vigor, with the women of Bankisole village.
- A new coaching center initiated at Bonkati village (Catholic Dahi) in Bankisole (Jhargram district).
- A new mother's group has evolved after the sensitization programme and training on 'Income Generation Activities' by SKC staff. The group is assembling LED bulbs in the Bankisole community center as a source of an additional livelihood option for them.



 **Impact:**

- Total 40 deprived students from marginalized families are regularly attending SKC's coaching center and have performed extremely well in the school examination, simultaneously the extracurricular activities in the coaching centers have enhance children's participation and performance.
- 7 mothers have started assembling LED bulbs at Bankisole after the hands on training as a part of IGA to support their families.
- Total 21 families has cultivated nutrition gardens in their houses with the help of the vegetable seeds distributed by SKC, following the Ecological farming mode.
- Total 2 irregular students were regularized through proper counselling and motivation.
- A new coaching center initiated at Bonkati village (Catholic Dahi) in Bankisole (Jhargram district) providing free educational support to 45 deprived students from marginalized families.
- For the very first time occasions like Environment Day, Independence Day and Women's Day were celebrated in these rural villages, resulting in knowledge and awareness building of the rural participants residing in these forest tracks.



Story of Change:

Title: 'Back to School'

Village: Hatighosa village in Jhargram district.

Rabilal Mandi a 10 year old boy of Hatighosa village in the Jhargram district of West Bengal, was an irregular students and frequently escaped school and was involved in other activities like fishing, hunting in the forest, flying kites, roaming here and there etc. He did not like to go to School, because he lacked interest in the daily syllabus rather was attracted towards his other hidden passions. His parents got repeated warnings from the School for the irregularity of their son, but the parents were helpless, as he would not listen to them.

Finally, his parents approached the SKC's coaching center at Hatighosa village, where the daily lessons are imparted through the 'Joyful learning methodology'. The SKC's Educational team approached Rabilal and told him about the different games and sports, which are a part of the coaching center. Rabilal too liked the welcoming environment of the coaching center, which was very different from the school set up. Education was imparted through various IEC materials, which succeeded in capturing the attention of Rabilal. He was interested to attend the classes and the other extra- curricular activities too.

The SKC's Educational Team even managed in regularizing him in the formal school, presently Rabilal is promoted to standard IV. His parents are grateful to Seva Kendra Calcutta, for implementing such a useful project, which has brought a positive change in the behaviour and mind set of their child, who is back to School again.
